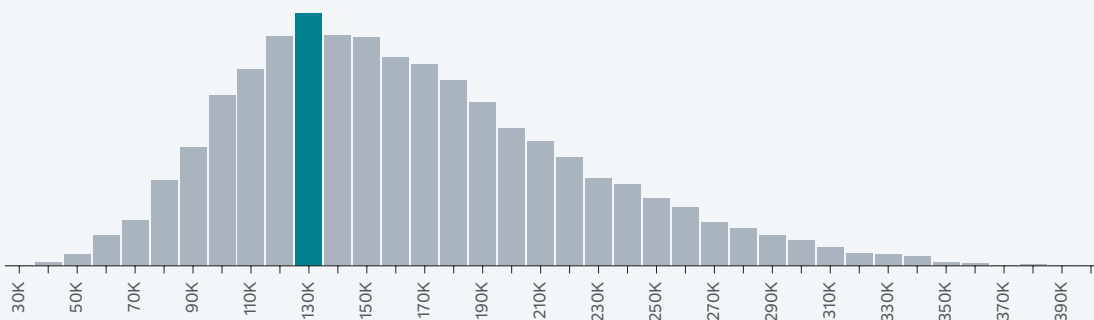

Downgrade milk means the farm failed to meet one or more of the Co-op's milk quality standards. This was previously referred to as grading.
